

## **Spring River's Beef Bowl Main Event Rules**

1. This is a scratch 5-pin tournament open to all bowlers with or without an established average.
2. ENTRY FEE is \$225 for your first shift, \$200 for any reentry shifts. Entry fee for any current YBC bowler is \$200. Payment will ONLY be accepted as CASH.
3. The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the tournament committee. The following shift entry cap's will be in place to ensure the tournament remains on schedule:  
Fri 8:30am - 48 entries, Fri 2:00pm - 64 entries, Sat 8:30am - 64 entries, Sat 2:30pm - 80 entries
4. Bowlers will receive one priority shift up to August 22nd, 2025
5. Prize money of \$43000 is based on a minimum of 175 entries in the main event.
6. The tournament will consist of four - 8 game qualifying shifts. Bowlers may enter all shifts but may only qualify once to advance to Sunday's match play.
7. At the conclusion of the four qualifying shifts, the 32 bowlers with the highest pinfall will advance to Sunday's match play step ladder.
8. The Sunday Playoffs will consist of an A and B division. The A side will be matchplay based on qualifying position and will be a 3 game total pinfall. In the event of a tie, the winner will be awarded to the bowler with 2 game wins. The B side will be matchplay based on a random draw and will be best of 3 matches. In the event of a tie, total pinfall wins.
9. The Finals will be the winner from A side playing winner from B side in a 3 game total pinfall match.
10. In the event of a tie for 32nd spot, a one game roll off will be held. In the event of a tie in the final match, the winner of 2 games will be declared champion.
11. The tournament committee will decide on any matters that may arise during the event, and their decision will be final.
12. The tournament committee and Panorama Lanes reserve the right to refuse any entry before or during the tournament. Their decision will be final
13. C5PBA rules will be in effect.
14. There may be use of multimedia, including video live streaming, on the internet throughout the tournament. By paying an entry fee for any shift/event, bowlers consent to the use of their image and name.
